



# CONGREGATIONAL CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER STUDENT PERSONAL TECHNOLOGY CONTRACT

***Students attending CCDC during the virtual learning time will be allowed to bring their own computer/tablet. Students and parents involved in bringing a personal electronic device to CCDC must adhere to the Student Personal Technology Contract as well as all other policies listed in the center handbook.***

- 1.) Students who bring personal technology to CCDC will have access to their devices for limited time during the day and only at the request of and under the supervision of a classroom teacher during the online learning time.
- 2.) Students take full responsibility for the security of their devices. CCDC is not responsible for personal devices that become lost, stolen, and/or damaged while at CCDC. Personal devices cannot be left at CCDC after closing hours.
- 3.) Students must comply with the teachers request to shut down devices or close the screen when asked. Devices must be in silent mode and put away when asked by teachers.
- 4.) Students are not permitted to transmit or post any photographic images/videos of any person on any public and/or private social media sites.
- 5.) Students who bring personally owned electronic devices to CCDC do so at their own risk and should not share their personal devices with other students.
- 6.) Printing from personal devices will not be permitted at CCDC.
- 7.) CCDC has the right to collect and examine any device that is used to determine whether it is being used inappropriately or is a possible threat to our network or other hardware.
- 8.) Inappropriate use, including but not limited to, a violation of CCDC policies and rules, procedures, state or federal law, may result in cancellation of the privilege to bring electronics into the building.
